North County CC seeks to create a safe, positive, and encouraging environment for children to grow, develop and participate in sport. Below are behavioural guidelines for young members & their parents/guardians in our club.

Young Players Code of Conduct:

- Participate for your own enjoyment, not to please parents or coaches.
- Always play fairly and by the rules.
- Trust, respect and cooperate with coaches, officials & umpires.
- Support and treat teammates & opponents with respect at all times.
- Work hard for yourself and your team.
- Own your performance & behaviour and always control your temper.
- Appreciate the importance of striving to win, not winning itself.
- Strive to attend all training and matches, arriving on time & with appropriate cricket gear.
- Respect the rights of every player & official regardless of ability, gender, race, or religion.
- Speak to coaches or Childrens Officer if you have any problems.

Parent/Guardians Code of Conduct:

- Appreciate your child's involvement in sport should be for their personal enjoyment, not yours.
- Always encourage children to play by the rules and respect officials' decisions, as you should do too.
- Cooperate with, show appreciation for and respect coaches, officials & umpires.
- Encourage & guide children to accept responsibility for their own behaviour & performance.
- Be positive, give praise and focus on children's efforts & participation rather than on winning or losing.
- Never ridicule young players for mistakes or losing.
- Emphasise the importance of striving to win, not winning itself.
- Refrain from using bad language around children.
- Support your children to arrive on time for training & matches with appropriate cricket gear.
- Pick children up at designated times after training & matches, respecting volunteers & officials time.
- Respect the rights of every player & official regardless of ability, gender, race, or religion.
- Speak to coaches or Childrens Officer if you have any problems.
